To our listeners and supporters,



What a year in food radio! As I reflect on my first full year as HRN Executive Director, I'm overwhelmed with gratitude for everyone who helped make it a success. We reached so many milestones, right from the start. In January, HRN celebrated our 10,000th episode. In March, we continued the 'On Tour' series by broadcasting over 60 interviews from the Charleston Wine and Food Festival. And by summer, our team moved to a slightly larger office down the street just in time to welcome some key new hires, to help us find even more innovative ways to raise the station's profile and cultivate stronger partnerships with people and organizations that care as deeply about great food and storytelling as we do.

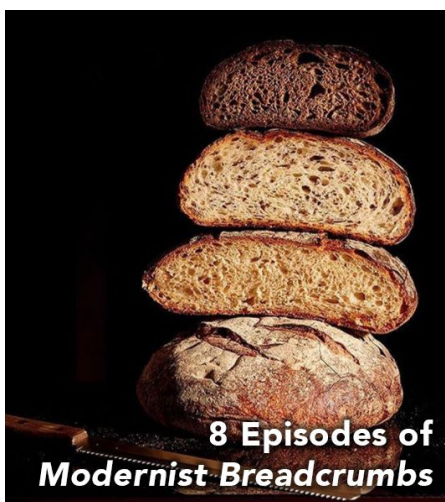

To create a more sustainable, equitable and delicious world by expanding the way eaters think about food.

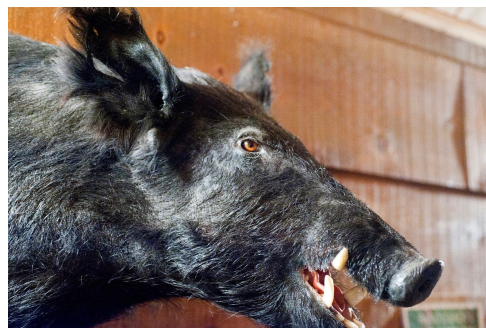
ABOUT HERITAGE RADIO NETWORK

THE HISTORY OF HRN



“The revolution needed a voice, something to punch through this insipid wall of tawdry, feel good fluff – so in 2009, largely inspired by Carlo Petrini’s 1975 pirate station in Italy, Radio Bra Onde Rosse, we began Heritage Radio Network, an Internet-based radio station out behind Roberta’s restaurant in Bushwick, Brooklyn. Carlo rescued an old military surplus transmitter to start his station; we built ours out of a couple of recycled shipping containers and put a garden on the roof.

Roberta’s had opened a few months earlier and was at the vanguard of a new generation of restaurants that were at once cool and sustainable. Roberta’s was unlike any other in America – the restaurant itself was built by the owners themselves of an

old auto body shop with rescued and recycled material, in an industrial district that nearly burned to the ground during the great blackout of 1977. Now it is very much at the hub of a fantastic new food movement, and the food that comes out of the pizza station and kitchen is delicious... The station started as something of a clubhouse for subversive foodies but has grown into a legitimate media outlet- we are a source for hard news and opinion, a beacon for like-minded progressives who do not view food as simply fodder for the style section.”

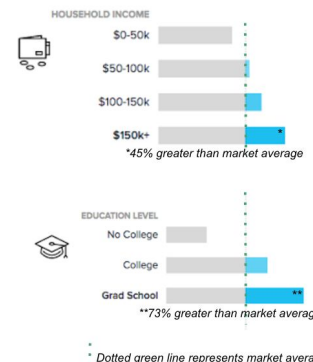

JENNA LIUT *Eating Matters*

New York City Food Policy's 40 Under 40

Jenna was named to the The New York City Food Policy Center's annual class of New York City's 40 individuals under 40 years old who are working to transform the food system. The Food Policy Center's honorees include policymakers, educators, community advocates, farmers and innovators who are making significant strides to create healthier, more sustainable food environments and to use food to promote community and economic development.



CHRIS CUZME *Fuhmentaboutit!*

Co-Founder, Fifth Hammer Brewing Company

Cuzme and his business partner, David Scharfstein opened Fifth Hammer Brewing Company in late October 2017. Fifth Hammer is a 15-barrel brewery located in the heart of Long Island City, New York. Their taproom is open 7 days/week, and you can even catch Cuzme playing saxophone if you find yourself there on the right day of the week!

MICHAEL HARLAN TURKELL *The Food Seen*

Author, *Acid Trip* | Co-Author, *Offal Good*

In addition to hosting *The Food Seen* and *Modernist BreadCrumbs* on HRN this year, Michael also had two new books released. The first, *Acid Trip: Travels in the World of Vinegar* has taken him on tour across the country to demonstrate the joys of cooking with acidity. *Offal Good* was co-written with Chef Chris Cosentino of Cockscomb.





CYNTHIA MALARAN *Wedding Cake*

DJ Cherish The Luv: Music Missionary

Cynthia, a survivor of breast cancer, was chosen to be one of the ambassadors for Pfizer's 'This is Living with Cancer' app, which helps those currently in treatment organize and manage their day-to-day life. She was featured on a billboard in Times Square in October (Breast Cancer Awareness Month) and in a short documentary film about how her life changed after her diagnosis. She's also the resident DJ of Whole Foods!

HARRY ROSENBLUM *Feast Yr Ears*

Author, *Vinegar Revival* | CEO, The Brooklyn Kitchen

Harry's book *Vinegar Revival: Artisanal Recipes for Brightening Dishes and Drinks with Homemade Vinegars* debuted in August. It includes dozens of recipes to encourage home cooks to not only cook with, but to make their own vinegars at home! Harry is also the CEO of The Brooklyn Kitchen – a radical cooking school – which opened a second location in Industry City in 2017.



KATY KEIFFER *What Doesn't Kill You*

Author, *What's the Matter with Meat?*

Katy's first book, *What's the Matter with Meat?* explores everything from labor issues to genetic manipulation to animal welfare to environmental degradation, illustrating just how the industrial model for meat production conjures up huge quantities of cheap meat even as it shifts many of the real costs onto the taxpayer.

SOTHER TEAGUE *The Speakeasy*

***Wine Enthusiast's* Mixologist of the Year**

Sother Teague is the head bartender at Amor y Amargo in the East Village, and part of the team behind Coup, a bar that raised money for charities being threatened by the current government. For his work to raise awareness for the betterment and social responsibility of the bar industry, as well as his support of numerous charitable causes and organizations, *Wine Enthusiast* named Sother Mixologist of the Year.

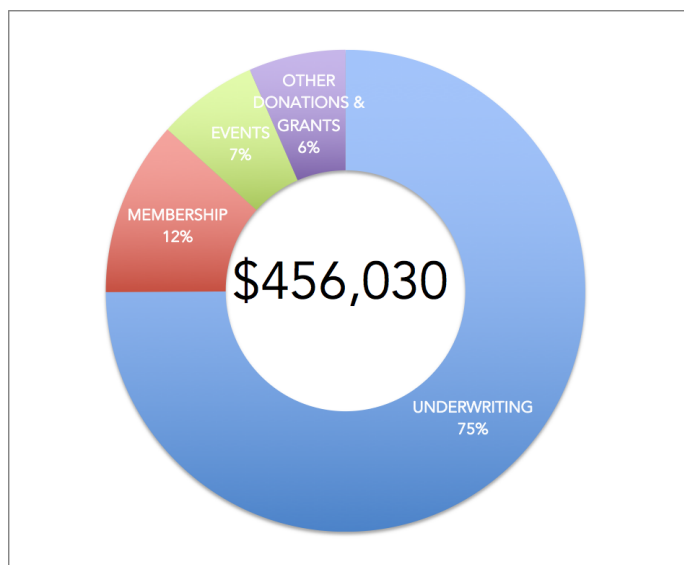
INCOME AND EXPENSES

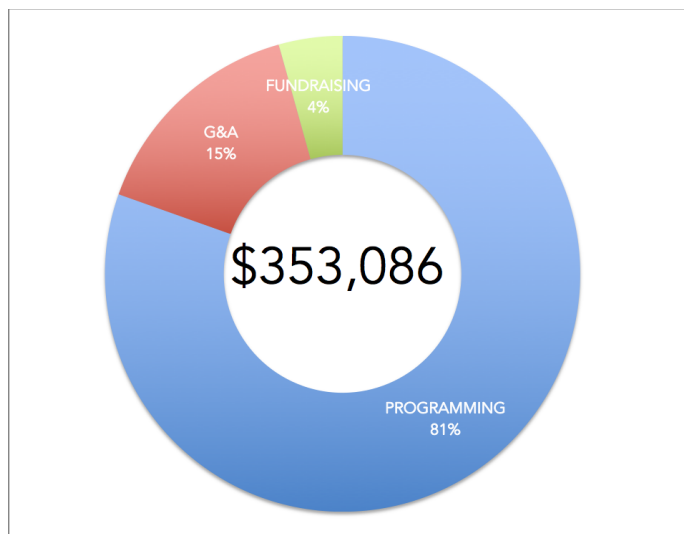
